





**Marquis White** 

1 Shout out, do not hold back! Lift up your voice like a trumpet! 





A reading from the prophet Ezekiel, chapter 37, verses 1 through 10:

God's power overcame me, and while I was in the Spirit, God led me out and set me down in the middle of a certain valley. It was full of bones. God led me through them all around, and I saw that there were a great many of them on the valley floor, and they were very dry.

God asked me, "Human one, can these bones live again?" I said, "Only you know."




